Dear Interested Parties:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) issued a draft permit for public review and comment from December 1999 to January 2000 for the Evergreen Environmental Services – Carson facility at 16604 South San Pedro Street in Carson. Due to the numerous comments received, and to a significant reduction of DTSC staff since that time, there has been a delay in responding to the comments and making a final decision.

DTSC issued the Response to Comments in October 2003 but did not make a final decision since so much time had elapsed since the initial public review period. In addition, DTSC has revised the draft permit and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study in response to the comments we received.

DTSC is inviting the public to comment on the revised draft permit, CEQA Initial Study, and proposed Negative Declaration. None of the revisions substantially change the previously draft permit or the findings of the Negative Declaration.

Enclosed is a fact sheet for your information and the revised draft permit and CEQA documents for your review. The Standardized Permit Application may be reviewed at the locations listed in the fact sheet. Comments on these documents will be accepted in writing until June 18, 2004 and must be sent to Alfred Wong at the Department of Toxic Substances Control, 700 Heinz Avenue, Berkeley, California 94710.
