**NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION –  
EVERGREEN ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES – CARSON, 16604 SOUTH SAN  
PEDRO STREET, CARSON, CALIFORNIA, EPA ID No. CAD 981696420**

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Evergreen Environmental Services – Carson  
16604 South San Pedro Street  
Carson, California 90746  
EPA ID No. CAD 981696420

This Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit authorizes Evergreen Environmental Services – Carson to store and transfer used oil, waste antifreeze, non-RCRA wastewater, and solid wastes contaminated with oil, and to treat used oil, at its facility located at 16604 South San Pedro Street in Carson, California. On March 26, 2009, DTSC published public notices in the Los Angeles Daily News (an English language newspaper) and the La Opinion Daily Newspaper (a Spanish language newspaper) to announce the start of a 45-day public comment period to solicit comments on the Draft Permit. Copies of a fact sheet (in English and Spanish) were mailed to the facility mailing list. A paid public notice announcing the public comment period was aired on a local radio station. A public meeting and hearing was held at the Ambler Avenue Elementary School on April 30, 2009. The public comment period ended on May 11, 2009. Public comments were received during the public hearing and by electronic mail.

DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments (RTC) document and made some minor changes to the Draft Permit for clarification purposes. The Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit becomes effective on August 5, 2009 unless a review is requested pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft permit or participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the

draft to the final permit. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period to the extent required by the regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.
