FIELDWORK ACTIVITIES for STORM WATER SYSTEM REPAIR

Exide

2700 South Indiana Street, Vernon, Los Angeles County, California

Exide is currently using a storm water management system to collect the daily wash water and rainwater which are drained to an onsite tank system for solids settlement and stabilization prior to the discharge into the sanitary sewer system. In 2012, Exide conducted a pipeline inspection and submitted an inspection report which recommended pipe replacement. Subsequently, an emergency response interim measures workplan and a stormwater replacement plan were submitted to describe the procedures to implement the recommendations.

Exide has proposed the following activities in the emergency response:

- 1) Removal or isolation of the existing pipelines
- 2) Sampling along the former pipeline corridor to determine the extent of any contamination (lateral and vertical)
- 3) Excavation and removal of contaminated soil.
- 4) Replacement of a stormwater management system.
- 5) Backfilling of the excavated area with clean soil and pavement restoration.
- 6) Relocation of the underground roof drains to above-grade.

You may see workers and heavy equipment in your neighborhood starting August 31, 2013. Dust, noise and disruptions to traffic will be closely monitored and managed. Supporting documents (e.g., CEQA documents and approved workplans) can be found at the following locations:
