The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has reviewed the letter dated April 10, 2015, from Exide Technologies (Exide) (Letter) regarding the shipment schedule for reverb feed material at the Exide facility in Vernon. The Letter was written in response to DTSC's letter dated April 2, 2015, which denied a request for an extension until June 1 to ship reverb feed material out of the Containment Building. The Letter responds to comments made in DTSC's April 2 letter and again requests an extension to June 1, 2015.

The Letter does not include any new information that would change DTSC's decision to deny the original request for an extension. DTSC set the May 1, 2015 deadline irrespective of any actual work-week schedule.
