The mission of DTSC is to protect California's people and environment from harmful effects of toxic substances through the restoration of contaminated resources, enforcement, regulation and pollution prevention.

## Briefing Period Announced for Appeal of the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Modification Issued to Filter Recycling Services, Inc.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) issued a final Class 2 permit modification decision on April 21, 2014, for the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for the Filter Recycling Services, Inc. (FRS) facility located at 180 West Monte Avenue, Rialto, California, 92316. DTSC received a Petition for Review (appeal) regarding the Class 2 permit modification decision on May 27, 2014 from FRS (Petitioner). On August 25, 2014, DTSC's Permit Appeals Officer issued the ORDER TO SET BRIEFING PERIOD FOR PETITION FOR REVIEW, Docket PAT-FY14/15-001, granting review for five appeal comments. The Order stays the permit modification decision until the final decision on these comments is issued.

This notice announces DTSC's initial decision on the appeal and establishes a briefing schedule for the purpose of allowing individuals an opportunity to file written comments concerning the five issues that have been granted review.

The appeal briefing period has alternating submittal of written arguments by the Petitioner and DTSC as follows: Petitioner submits arguments by September 18, 2014, DTSC submits arguments by October 3, 2014, and Petitioner submits final arguments by October 17, 2014. The submitted documents will be posted on DTSC's Permit Appeals website listed below. DTSC invites any interested person to submit written arguments addressing only the issues that have been granted review. DTSC cannot consider arguments that do not meet the content and filing requirements stated above. After considering submitted arguments, DTSC will issue an order with the final permit modification decision.

Persons who submit written arguments may also request DTSC to hold an Informal Appeals Conference, so that they may present their arguments orally to DTSC. If granted by DTSC, the Informal Appeals Conference will be scheduled after the close of the briefing period.
