What Is Being Proposed?

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comment on the proposed modified permit for Filter Recycling Services, Inc. (FRS) located at 180 W. Monte Avenue, Rialto, California. This permit modification authorizes FRS to modify its current permit for its operating hazardous waste storage and treatment facility. DTSC invites you to review this draft modified Permit and send us your comments. We also invite you to comment on the proposed Negative Declaration prepared to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

DTSC regulates the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. A permit is one of the tools used DTSC to regulate the hazardous waste management activities at facilities. Permits are developed after DTSC's technical review and are intended to ensure that the facility operates in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

Why This Notice and How You Can Participate

This notice provides the public an opportunity to learn more about FRS and submit public comment on the proposed permit modification and CEQA proposed Negative Declaration. The 45-day public comment period begins on February 15, 2013, and ends on April 2, 2013.
