NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION FOR THE GENERAL ELECTRIC INTERNATIONAL INC. LOS ANGELES SERVICE CENTER, 3601 E. LA PALMA AVENUE, ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA, EPA ID NUMBER CAD 030584502

To Interested Parties:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for the General Electric International Inc. Los Angeles Service Center located at 3601 East La Palma Avenue in the City of Anaheim, California. The Final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14.

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.9, DTSC sent a notice of the Draft Permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government. The Public notice was published in the Anaheim Bulletin on April 14, 2016 and a radio announcement was made on April 14, 2016 on KOST 103.5 FM. The public comment period for the Draft Permit started on April 14, 2016 and ended on May 31, 2016. A Public Meeting/hearing was held on May 17, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Embassy Suites Hotel, 3100 Frontera Street, Anaheim, California 92806. DTSC received no written comments from the community during the public comment period and no members of the public participated in or made oral comments at the public meeting/hearing.

DTSC prepared an Environmental Document Analysis (EDA) document in 2016 which compared current project activities to those previously analyzed in 1993, compared conditions at the site and in the surrounding area, and ensured that the proposed project meets current regulatory standards. In accordance with the requirements of Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, DTSC determined that a Negative Declaration prepared for issuance of the 1993 Permit provided an accurate description of proposed project activities, and that the conditions requiring preparation of a subsequent environmental impact report are not present. Therefore, pursuant to Public Resources Code 21166 and California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15162, no additional CEQA documentation is necessary to support issuance of the Final Permit. DTSC will file a new Notice of Determination for the Final Permit.

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The Final Permit is issued by DTSC on June 22, 2016, and becomes effective on June 22, 2016, in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14.

Procedures for appealing a permit decision are described in California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18, which provides that any person who filed comments on the Draft Permit, or participated in the public hearing may petition the Department to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the Draft Permit, or who failed to participate in the public hearing, may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision.

Since there were no comments received on the Draft Permit requesting a change to the Draft Permit, there were no substantive changes to the final permit from the Draft Permit, and there were no members of the public who participated in the hearing, the permit decision may not be appealed.
