REVISED CORRECTIVE MEASURES IMPLEMENTATION WORKPLAN FOR GENERAL DYNAMICS ORDNANCE TEST SITE TRACY CALIFORNIA Approval date: July 25, 2008



WHAT DID DTSC DECIDE?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has approved the Revised Corrective Measures Implementation Work Plan, Solid Waste Management Unit Number 21 (Work Plan), Tracy Test Facility, General Dynamics Ordnance Test Site Incorporated, located at 32727 Corral Hollow Road in Tracy. Based on the Work Plan, General Dynamics OTS will add a two percent hydrogen peroxide solution to the groundwater to enhance natural degradation of mineral oil contamination. Groundwater monitoring will be conducted for a year, after which, DTSC will evaluate the treatment's effectiveness and the need for further monitoring. This site used to be known as Primex Technologies Tracy Test Facility.

Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC has finished its review of the potential health and environmental impacts from the Work Plan. Based on this analysis, DTSC has filed a CEQA Notice of Exemption.
