The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed the technical review of the Post Closure Permit Application dated April 26, 2012 with subsequent revisions dated June 27, 2012, July 10, 2012 and July 18, 2012 (Approved Application) for the former International Light Metals facility located at 19200 Western Avenue, Torrance, California.

DTSC considers the Post Closure Permit Application listed above to be technically complete. DTSC has also drafted a Notice of Exemption for the post closure permit to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.

The draft Permit and Administrative Record will be made available for public review and comment during the comment period. DTSC will also hold a public meeting prior to the issuance of a final permit decision. If DTSC determines that additional information is needed to clarify, modify or supplement previously submitted material, DTSC reserves the right to require this information from Lockheed Martin Corporation. You will soon receive a notice of public comment period and public meeting for the draft permit.
