Current Status of Permit Appeal for INDUSTRIAL SERVICE OIL COMPANY, INC. (ISOCI) 1700 South Soto Street, Los Angeles, CA 90023

The State of California's Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is reviewing "Appeal Comments" as we consider whether to change the permit allowing ISOCI to expand and modify current operations, and to continue storing and treating hazardous waste. These 20 comments, made during the appeal period, are the only ones the Department is allowed to consider during this final comment period. The law does not allow new comments to be raised or reviewed.

The enclosed Public Notice announces a 45-day public comment period **from September 6 to October 26, 2007** (also called a briefing period) when the public can submit written comments (also known as legal briefs). Arguments must address one or more of issues raised in the 20 Appeal Comments.
