### AMENDED NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION FOR INDUSTRIAL SERVICE OIL COMPANY, INC.

The 30-day period to submit a petition for review of the final permit decision has been extended to March 5, 2007 to allow additional response time due to requests from community members.

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Amended Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Industrial Service Oil Company, Inc.

Los Angeles County

On December 15, 2005, DTSC announced a 60-day public comment period on the draft permit and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) draft Environmental Impact Report (dEIR). That comment period ran from December 15, 2005 through February 13, 2006. A public hearing was held on January 21, 2006 at the Ross Snyder Recreational Center, 1501 East 41<sup>ST</sup> Street, Los Angeles, California 90011. During the initial public comment period and at the public hearing, members of the community requested an extension to the 60-day comment period. DTSC extended the comment period until April 14, 2006 (for a total of 120 days).

Other comments were also received during the public hearing and by electronic and postal mail. DTSC has prepared a Response to the Comments document and made changes to the Draft Permit in response to public comments. A copy of the Response to Comments documents has been mailed sent to each commenter. The Response to Comments document, the DTSC memorandum to file listing the revisions made to the Draft Permit in response to public comments, and a redline/strikeout version of the permit showing all the

changes from the Draft to the Final permit, are available to the public at the repositories listed at the end of this Notice.

In its role as Lead Agency under the provisions of the CEQA, DTSC prepared an EIR to evaluate potential impacts from the proposed project and identify mitigation measures. After a final permit decision has been issued under CCR, title 22, section 66271.14, any person who filed comments on that draft permit or participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. The period within which a person may request review under section 66271.18 began on December 21, 2006 and has been extended to end on March 5, 2007. The permit becomes effective on March 6, 2007, unless a petition for review is filed. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including any public hearing), or were not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the public comment period. When appropriate, the petition must show that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law that is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.
