WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites your comments and provides opportunities for public participation during the **60-day public comment period** on the **draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Draft Permit)** and a **Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR)** for the Industrial Service Oil Company, Inc. (ISOCI) facility located at 1700 South Soto Street, Los Angeles, California. If approved, DTSC would issue the ISOCI facility a Final Permit to store and treat hazardous waste, and the Permit would be in effect for ten years. ISOCI is an existing hazardous waste management facility presently operating under Interim Status Document granted by DTSC in 1986.

ISOCI currently operates a hazardous waste recycling, storage and treatment facility. The facility plans to store and treat wastes in 46 tanks. In addition, eight treatment and storage units will be added as part of the permit. The Draft Permit includes a number of existing treatment processes and units, including an used oil recycling system and spent antifreeze storage/transfer. New operations in the Draft Permit include two container management areas, glycol (i.e., antifreeze) recovery, wastewater treatment, fuel blending, and waste solids treatment. Changes are proposed for the storage and treatment capacities of the used oil recycling system and rail-car loading and unloading operations. In addition, a partial closure of the former location of the used oil storage tanks will be conducted. The partial closure will involve soil sampling and remediation, if necessary. You may comment on any aspect of the **Draft Permit**.

Under the California Environmental Quality Act (**CEQA**), DTSC must evaluate whether the proposed actions may have any significant impacts on the environment and human health. In order to do this analysis, DTSC has prepared a DEIR and Health Risk Assessment (HRA) for this project.

WHY THIS NOTICE?

The purpose of this notice is to provide to the interested community an opportunity to learn about the project and provide comments to DTSC by February 13, 2006 on the draft Permit and the DEIR.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

Your participation is encouraged. **The 60-day public comment period begins on December 15, 2005 and end on February 13, 2006. Comments must be postmarked, delivered or e-mailed by February 13, 2006.**

Also, you can submit your comments (oral or written) at the Public Hearing on January 21st, 2006 (10 a.m. to 12 noon) at the Ross Snyder Recreational Center, 1501 East 41st Street, Los Angeles, CA 90011.

At the close of the comment period, the DTSC will prepare a Response to Comments document and send it to everyone who has submitted comments and provided their name and address. Everyone who provides written comments and/or signs in at the public hearing will be notified of the decision.
