FORMER INTERNATIONAL LIGHT METALS FACILITY DRAFT POST-CLOSURE PERMIT, TORRANCE, CA

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED: The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a draft Post-Closure Permit for the former International Light Metals facility located at 19200 South Western Avenue in the City of Torrance, Los Angeles County, California.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the 10-year post-closure permit would require long-term groundwater monitoring, site inspections, repair and maintenance of the monitoring wells and cover.

As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft post-closure permit as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption for this project. The extended public comment period begins December 5, 2012 and ends on January 25, 2013.
