The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is inviting the public to comment on a draft land use covenant for the Jackson Family Trust site located at 235 Tennant Avenue, Morgan Hill, California. The site was formerly owned by Contraves, Inc. Soil beneath a building (Building B) is contaminated with Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons from past operations. The draft land use covenant proposes leaving the contamination in place and restricting future use of the site to commercial/industrial activities.

The public comment period runs from September 14 through October 14, 2007
