CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, verifying upon information and belief, complains that in the County of Kings, State of California, the defendant did commit the following crimes:

COUNT 1

On or about January 23, 2013, said defendant **JEFFREY A. PRINS** did commit a **MISDEMEANOR**, namely: a violation of section 25190 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, in that said defendant did violate a rule, regulation, standard, or requirement issued or adopted pursuant to chapter 6.5 of division 20 of the Health and Safety Code, commonly known as the Hazardous Waste Control Law, relating to handling, disposal, and storage of hazardous and universal wastes at 866 East Fifth Street and 10716 Eighth Avenue in Hanford, California, 93230.

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COUNT 2

On or about January 23, 2013, said defendant **JEFFREY A. PRINS** did commit a **MISDEMEANOR**, namely: a violation of section 25212 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, in that said defendant failed to remove materials requiring special handling (MRSH) from major appliances in which they were contained prior to the appliances being crushed, baled, shredded, sawed or sheared apart, disposed of, or otherwise processed in a manner that could result in a release or could prevent the removal of materials that require special handling at 866 East Fifth Street in Hanford, California, 93230.
