A draft permit hazardous waste permit renewal for Kinsbursky Brothers Supply, Inc., located near the Riverside Freeway (State Route 91) and North Anaheim Boulevard, is available for public review and comment. The renewed Hazardous Waste Permit would allow the facility to continue its hazardous waste storage and treatment activities for another 10 years.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

March 28, 2011 through May 11, 2011

The public comment period for the draft Permit, and draft Negative Declaration begins on March 28, 2011 and ends May 11, 2011. Why a Permit is Necessary

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is a department within the California Environmental Protection Agency. DTSC regulates the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California.

A permit enables DTSC to effectively regulate the hazardous waste management activities at facilities. DTSC is authorized to impose special conditions in this Permit pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25200(a) and the regulations in California Code of Regulations, title 22, division 4.5, governing tanks, containers, and other facility operation standards. Permits are developed after DTSC's technical review, and are intended to ensure that the facility operates in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

Facility Description and History

Kinsbursky is a battery and precious metal recycling facility located in an industrial zoned area of the northern portion of Orange County. The main business activities at Kinsbursky are:

Reclamation of batteries, catalytic converters and waste solder

Recovery of precious metals from scrap electronic and electrical parts, silver chips, sludge and metal bearing solution

Handling of universal waste

Treatment and storage of hazardous waste

Kinsbursky started to operate in 1977 and submitted its Part A and Part B application in 1988. A hazardous waste facility permit was issued in 1989 and renewed in 1998 for 10 years. In December 2007, the Facility submitted its permit renewal application which proposed to continue storage and treatment of batteries, precious metals and hazardous waste with some modifications.

Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit

The proposed hazardous waste facility permit authorizes continued operation of lead acid and non lead acid battery storage and processing activities, storage and treatment of precious metal containing solutions, storage of metal

containing solid wastes and treatment of wastewater generated onsite. The Facility is also proposing some significant modifications to its current hazardous waste management operations which are:

- Addition of two automated battery processing units,
- Relocation and re-configuration of the hazardous waste management units,
- Re-classification of catalytic converter media to non-hazardous waste and
- Increase in the storage and treatment capacity for batteries.
- Increase in the wastewater treatment capacity

California Environmental Quality Act

Under the California Environmental Quality Act, DTSC must evaluate whether the proposed actions may have any significant impacts on human health and the environment. As part of this evaluation, DTSC has proposed a Negative Declaration which concludes that renewal of this facility's permit will not result in any impact to human health or the environment.

Compliance History

Kinsbursky Brothers Supply, Inc., has been inspected by DTSC on a routine basis since the issuance of their permit in 1989. During the past three years, inspectors uncovered minor violations which included:

- Failure to maintain secondary containment in order
- Required labeling
- Deficiencies in the operating records
- Isle spacing
- Required annual waste minimization certification

The Facility was also cited for failure to submit an exception report to DTSC within 90 days of the initial shipment of the hazardous waste to foreign countries. All violation were corrected.

DTSC conducted an inspection in February 2010 and no violation was found at that inspection.

You Can Participate in Our Decisions

Before making a final determination on the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, DTSC will review and respond in writing to all public comments. A Response to Comments document will be sent to all those who submitted public comments and to those who request a copy. A copy of the Response to Comments will also be placed in the information repositories.

The Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit renewal and other site-related documents are available for public review at the information repositories listed here. The administrative record is available in the DTSC office in Chatsworth. The administrative record includes copies of the permit application, the Draft CEQA Negative Declaration, this fact sheet and other site-specific documents.
