NOTICE OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE: December 15, 2016, through April 3, 2017

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces a briefing schedule for individuals to file written comments concerning the appeal of a hazardous waste facility permit for Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL), located at 7000 East Avenue, Livermore, California. DTSC issued a final permit decision (Permit) for the LLNL facility on March 11, 2016.

DTSC received one appeal (Petition for Review) regarding the Permit from Tri-Valley Communities Against a Radioactive Environment (CAREs) on April 21, 2016. DTSC issued the "Order Partially Granting Petition for Review and Denial of Review," Docket PAT-FY16/17-001 (Order) granting review for three (3) of the appeal comments on December 1, 2016. These appeal comments are identified in the Order as Comments 2, 7, and 9. Comment 2 claims the permit application is inadequate because it does not provide information required by regulation, lacks detail, and does not provide implementing procedures or descriptions. Comment 7 claims DTSC has not followed its policy concerning authorizing delayed closure for hazardous waste management units and has not demonstrated certain units were closed in accordance with approved plans. Comment 9 claims that changes to the permit in response to comments from LLNL were not appropriately evaluated or provided public review. DTSC has established a briefing schedule for individuals to file written arguments concerning only the three appeal comments granted review. A sequential briefing schedule will be used as follows:

- Tri-Valley CAREs and interested persons supporting the appeal may submit briefs concerning the appeal comments granted review to be received by DTSC no later than **February 13, 2017**; and,
- DTSC's Permitting Division and interested persons supporting the permit may submit briefs responding to Tri-Valley CAREs' brief and any interested person briefs to be received by DTSC no later than **April 3, 2017**.

DTSC will post the briefs on the appeals webpage listed above as they are received and notify the parties via email about the availability of the briefs. Interested persons should monitor DTSC appeals webpage for the briefs. Written arguments must be restricted to the issues granted review and must include a supporting statement of reasons.

DTSC cannot consider arguments that do not meet these content and filing requirements. After considering the submitted written arguments, DTSC will issue an Order with the final permit appeals decision. The Permit is stayed until a final decision on these appeal comments is issued.

As part of a written argument submission, interested persons may request DTSC to hold an Informal Appeals Conference (IAC) so that they may present their arguments orally to DTSC. Only individuals who submit written arguments may present them at the IAC. If requested, the IAC will be scheduled after the close of the briefing period at the discretion of the Permit Appeals Officer.
