**30-Day PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
July 16, 2007 through August 14, 2007**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a proposed Interim Measures Plan (cleanup plan) for the former Microsemi Facility. The primary objective of the cleanup plan is to apply Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) technology to soil located at the site in order to reduce concentrations of chemicals known as chlorinated solvents.

The facility was used to manufacture electronic parts since 1963, Microsemi purchased the property in 1985, and ceased manufacturing operations in 2005. In 2007, Microsemi entered into a Corrective Action Consent Agreement with DTSC and agreed that chemicals left at the site would be cleaned up to levels acceptable for future industrial and commercial land use.

The proposed SVE system will be continuously operated until chemicals currently present in soil decline to safe levels. The length of time the system will operate will be determined through a process of monitoring and periodic soil testing. The need for future cleanup actions at the facility will be evaluated following further investigations and completion of the proposed Interim Measures Plan.

As required by California Law, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed Interim Measures Plan in accordance with this California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on the review, DTSC has determined that the proposed cleanup of soil will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment, and proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption in connection with this project. The proposed California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Notice of Exemption is available for public review during the 30-day comment period from July 16 through August 14, 2007.
