Dear Mr. Gordon:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed the review of the proposed Class I Permit Modification request dated July 27, 2006 for the Naval Station San Diego (aka Naval Base San Diego) Building 3458 San Diego, CA 92136-5000, California. This request modifies your current Hazardous Waste Facility Permit issued on July 27, 2006.

The Class I Permit Modification request entails updating the Operator Facility Contact in both the Part A and Part B Applications. It also updates the "*Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures, Naval Station San Diego CST Facility*". It also corrects administrative oversights in the waste codes listed in the Part A and Table III-1 of the Part B Application. This information update does not change facility design or procedures.

Based on the information provided in the original Permit Modification request as well as the additional information supplied in subsequent correspondence, DTSC hereby approves the Class I Permit Modification in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42(d)(2)(A). The modifications made to the Operation Plan have been made part of the facility files. Attached is the modified Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for Naval Base San Diego. The permit cover page, page ii, page 3, page 8 and Appendix A of the Permit were modified and/or added to reflect the changes of this permit modification.

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In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42, Naval Base San Diego will send a public notice within 90 days from the date of this letter for the proposed modification to all persons on the facility's mailing list and the relevant appropriate entities of state and local government. Please replace your copy of the permit with the attached Hazardous Waste Facility Permit
