The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has reviewed and approved the following Class 1 permit modifications to the July 27, 2006 Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) for Naval Station San Diego, (Naval Base San Diego). This modification request entails updating the Operator Facility Contact in both the Part A and Part B Applications. It also updates the "*Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures, Naval Station San Diego CST Facility*". It also corrects administrative oversights in the waste codes listed in the Part A and Table III-1 of the Part B Application. This information update does not change facility design or procedures.

Naval Base San Diego submission dated May 30, 2007 for the facility at Building 3458. San Diego, California was reviewed by the DTSC. DTSC concurs that these updates and changes qualify as a Class 1 permit modification.
