FINAL PERMIT DECISION: P. KAY METAL, INC. FACILITY (EPA ID NUMBER CAL000024110)

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made its decision to issue the final Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit – Series B (SHWFP) for P. Kay Metal, Inc., located at 2448 East 25th Street, Los Angeles, California 90058.

DTSC also prepared a Notice of Exemption (NOE) for this permit renewal to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

In accordance with title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), section 66270.42(c), DTSC sent a notice of the draft Permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of state and local governments. The Notification was also published in the newspaper (Vernon Eastside Sun on February 5, 2009) and a radio announcement aired on February 5, 2009 on a local radio station.

The public comment period for the draft Permit and CEQA NOE was from February 6, 2009 to April 2, 2009. A public meeting was conducted on March 10, 2009 at the Huntington Park Library. DTSC received 32 comments concerning the proposed draft Permit and CEQA for P. Kay Metal, Inc. facility.

The final permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the CCR, title 22, section 66271.14. If DTSC does not receive an appeal on the final permit within 30 calendar days after the final permit decision, the 10-year Permit will become effective on October 31, 2009, and expire on October 31, 2019. The final day to submit a permit appeal is October 30, 2009.

Within 30 days after a final permit decision has been issued under CCR, title 22, section 66271.14, any person who filed comments on that draft permit or participated in the public meeting may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public meeting on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. The 30-day period within which a person may

request review under section 66271.18 begins September 30, 2009 and ends on October 30, 2009. The permit becomes effective on October 31, 2009, unless a petition for review is filed. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including any public hearing), or were not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the public comment period. When appropriate, the petition must show that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law that is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.

A petition must be postmarked no later than October 30, 2009, and must be submitted to:
