## **FINAL PERMIT DECISION: DEMENNO/KERDOON, 2000 NORTH ALAMEDA STREET, COMPTON, CALIFORNIA (EPA ID NO. CAT080013352)**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made its final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit to DeMenno/Kerdoon located at 2000 North Alameda Street, Compton, California. The final Permit incorporates changes to the draft Permit as a result of findings from the certified Environmental Impact Report (EIR), public comments received on the draft Permit and internal review by DTSC staff. A copy of the response to comments document and record of revisions are being sent to all persons who commented on the draft Permit or draft EIR during the public comment period. The final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Section 66271.14 and becomes effective on

July 6, 2001 unless a petition for review is filed pursuant to Title 22, CCR, Section 66271.18. It authorizes the facility to operate under certain specified conditions.

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The final Permit may be appealed in accordance with Title 22, CCR, Section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft Permit or who participated in the public hearing on the draft Permit may petition the DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft Permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft Permit to the final Permit.

The 30 day period within which a person may request review begins on June 4, 2001 and ends July 5, 2001. The petition must be sent to:

The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

- 1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
- 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should review.
