## DTSC Receives Permit Renewal Application From Pacific Scientific Energetic Materials Company Inc., 3601 Union Road, Hollister CA 95023

On April 11, 2016, The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the permit renewal application from Pacific Scientific Energetic Materials Company Inc. (Pacific Scientific). Pacific Scientific requests authorization from DTSC to continue the storage and treatment of hazardous waste. DTSC will evaluate the application to determine if it is complete. DTSC may request additional information from Pacific Scientific before determining completeness. If the application is determined to be complete, DTSC will then prepare a draft permit for public review and comment.

Pacific Scientific currently manufactures explosives and explosive devices for various commercial uses. Their waste management activities include treatment and storage of hazardous waste. The main treatment activity is open burning/open detonation of solvents and explosives. No hazardous wastes are accepted from off-site sources.

If DTSC renews the Permit, DTSC would continue to allow Pacific Scientific to treat and store hazardous waste. Their 290 acre facility is located about 2 miles south and west of the City of Hollister (please see the map). This permit would be in effect for ten years.
