FINAL PERMIT DECISION: QUEMETCO, INC., 720 S. 7<sup>TH</sup> AVE., CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA 91746 (EPA ID NO. CAD 066233966)

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made its final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit to Quemetco Inc., located at 720 S. 7<sup>th</sup> Ave., City of Industry, California 91746. The final Permit incorporates changes to the draft Permit as a result of findings from the certified Environmental Impact Report (EIR), public comments received on the draft Permit and internal review by DTSC staff. A copy of the response to comments document is being sent to all persons who commented on the draft Permit or draft EIR during the public comment period. The final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.14 and becomes effective on September 15, 2005 unless a petition for review is filed pursuant to title 22, CCR, section 66271.18. It authorizes the facility to operate under certain specified conditions.

The final Permit may be appealed in accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18(a), which provides that any person may petition the Department for review of any permit conditions that has been changed from a draft permit decision to the final permit decision. In addition, any person who filed comments, or participated in the public hearing, on a draft permit decision (during the public comment period for the draft permit decision) may petition the Department to review any condition of the permit decision, to the extent that the issues raised in the petition for review were either: (i) also raised during the public comment period for the draft permit decision, including the public

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hearing, or (ii) were not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the public comment period.

The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, including a demonstration that any issues raised were raised during the public comment period ( including any public hearing) to the extent required by these regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

- (1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
- (2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which the Department should, in its discretion, review.

The 30 day period within which a person may request review begins on August 16, 2005, and ends on September 14, 2005. The petition must be sent to:
