To Interested Parties:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) completed the review of a Class 1* permit modification request for the Raytheon Company (Raytheon) facility located at 2000 East El Segundo Boulevard, El Segundo, California. Based on the review, DTSC concurred that the modification request qualified as a Class 1* permit modification.

This Class 1* Permit Modification is a minor modification of the Closure Plan (CP) to reflect the closure cost estimate changes, and does not change the existing permit conditions or permitted storage capacity. The revised CP updates the closure cost estimate to the amount of \$757,150, pursuant to DTSC's August 15, 2005, request.

A copy of Raytheon's Assurance of Financial Responsibility document, a Standby Letter of Credit from the Bank of America for closure activities at multiple former Hughes Aircraft facilities, for the amount of ten million dollars and the liability coverage for the amount of 1 million per occurrence and the aggregate amount of two million dollars were included in Appendix F of the Closure Plan.

The hazardous waste facility permit was originally issued to Hughes Aircraft Company, Electro-Optical Systems on December 24, 1996, and became effective on January 27, 1997. DTSC approved the owner/operator change to Raytheon Company/Raytheon Systems Company-Sensor and Electronics System on June 30, 1997. Raytheon transfers and stores hazardous waste generated on-site and from other Raytheon facilities within 160 miles of the El Segundo facility.

Raytheon public noticed the Class 1* Permit Modification on October 6, 2005 in the Daily Breeze Newspaper. The notice was also sent to all persons on the facility mailing list. DTSC did not receive any comments regarding the proposed modification.

DTSC prepared a Notice of Exemption (NOE) for this Class 1* permit modification for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act. This NOE will be filed with the State Clearinghouse, Office of Planning and Research.
