APPEAL OF STANDARDIZED HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT FOR

Dear Messrs. Chandler and Manser:

Enclosed please find the initial ORDER PARTIALLY GRANTING PETITION FOR REVIEW, DENIAL OF REVIEW, AND VACATING STAY (Order) pertaining to the Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, Series C issued by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) on December 17, 2008, concerning the San Joaquin Filter Recycling, LLC facility located at 14287 E. Manning Avenue, Parlier, California, 93648.

Shortly, DTSC will issue a public notice announcing this decision and setting a briefing schedule for the issues that have been granted review under the Order. DTSC will use a three phase briefing schedule for this briefing period, which will be explained further in the public notice. After considering the arguments submitted during the briefing period, DTSC will issue a subsequent order setting forth its final decision on the appeal comments that were granted review.

Contested permit conditions and those that are not severable from contested permit conditions are stayed during the pendency of a permit appeal, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.15(a)(1). Appeal Comments 3 and 4, for which review has been granted, relate to matters that are severable from the other, uncontested conditions in the Permit. Therefore, pending resolution of this appeal, the stay shall be, and is hereby, vacated except as to Part VI, paragraph 2 of the Permit.
