# RCRA Facility Investigation Workplan

- Draft RCRA Facility Investigation Workplan  
November 14, 2006
- Required to contain:
  - ✓ Historical records and documentation
  - ✓ Listing of all wastes, waste types
  - ✓ Rationale for sampling, analyses
  - ✓ Corporate Certification
  - ✓ Radioactive materials screening procedures
  - ✓ Airborne chemical dispersion assessment

# Historical Documents

- More than 13,000 pages (certified complete record by Boeing in November 14, 2006 letter)
- We looked for:
  - Radiological Materials
  - Off-site sources
  - Unusual or significant information
- Preliminary findings:
  - March 1993 letter re: materials received from Area IV (letter from Energy Technology Engineering Center (ETEC)-clarification needed)
  - 1966 document regarding leaking dam from acid pit
  - 1961 topographic map showing 3 previously unknown pits

# Historical Documents

- At this time we have not found anything that would affect the investigation activities proposed in the Workplan

# Status of Review of Workplan

- DTSC is reviewing the Workplan and we want to incorporate your comments
- We hope to do the sampling in late spring/early summer

# Sediment and Erosion Control

- Erosion and Sediment Control Plan (August 2006)
- Plan approval in October 6, 2006
- Installation activities completed on November 2, 2006.
