This letter is to confirm our conversation on Wednesday, September 20, 2006 regarding the Area I Burn Pit RCRA Facility Investigation Workplan. The Workplan should include an in-depth evaluation of airborne chemical releases from the Area I Burn Pit operations, including air dispersion modeling of past activities and burning of wastes, and a compilation and use of a consistent, site-specific meteorological data set to improve the assessment of any potential releases in surrounding areas.
