WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a proposed Corrective Measures Proposal (CMP) for the 11.26 acre Former STMicroelectronics Facility (Site), located at 16350 West Bernardo Drive, San Diego. The primary objective of the CMP is to present a final remedy that will complete corrective action at the Site. The Site was initially developed as a semiconductor manufacturing plant, until 2002. The Site is currently developed with three office buildings and paved parking lots with limited landscaping. On September 24, 2001, STMicroelectronics, Inc. entered into a legally binding agreement with DTSC to investigate contamination located at the Site. The proposed corrective measure consists of implementation of a Land Use Covenant to ensure that future residential land use of the Site and the use of the on-Site groundwater for potable water uses are restricted.

DTSC has performed a review of the proposed corrective measure in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on the review, DTSC has determined that the CMP will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment, and proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE) in connection with this project. The proposed CEQA NOE is available for public review during the 30-day comment period.

Why This Notice and How You Can Participate

This notice provides you an opportunity to learn more about the site and submit public comments on the CMP and draft Notice of Exemption. The 30-day public comment period begins on October 1, 2012, and ends on October 30, 2012.
