Draft Permit Renewal is Available for Review and Comment for the Safety Kleen, Los Angeles Los Angeles County, California

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: January 20 through March 9, 2009

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal (Permit) for the Safety Kleen, Los Angeles facility located at 2918 Worthen Avenue, Los Angeles (facility). Safety Kleen, Los Angeles is an existing facility and the Permit will allow the facility to continue operations for an additional 10 years. The types and volumes of wastes handled and stored will not be changed.

The facility is a branch of a chemical distribution chain owned by the Safety Kleen System, Inc. The facility distributes parts cleaners to its customers. Safety Kleen's truck operators replace used cleaner solvents with virgin or recycled cleaner solvents at the customer's location, and transport the hazardous wastes back to the facility. The hazardous wastes at the facility are eventually transported to Safety Kleen's Reedley Recycle Center for recycling or to a permitted facility for disposal or treatment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT - NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Under the California Environmental Quality Act, DTSC must evaluate whether the proposed action will have any significant impacts on human health and the environment. As part of this evaluation, DTSC has proposed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) which concludes that renewal of this Permit will not result in any impact to human health or the environment. The draft NOE is available for public review.

WHY THIS NOTICE?

The purpose of this notice is to provide you with the opportunity to learn more about the draft Permit and to provide comments on it to DTSC by March 9, 2009.

Your participation is encouraged.
