NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc, Santa Ana Branch (Safety-Kleen)

This Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Final Permit) authorizes Safety-Kleen to store hazardous waste in a 12,000-gallon underground storage tank and two containers/drums storage areas. The hazardous waste stored at the Facility includes spent paint thinners, paint wastes, used oil, anti-freeze, immersion cleaner, dry cleaning solvents, spent parts washer solvents (mineral spirits), aqueous-based parts washing solution, industrial solvents, drum washer bottom sediments, and tank bottom sediments.

On November 17, 2006, DTSC published a public notice in the Orange County Register regarding DTSC's proposed decision on Safety-Kleen's permit renewal application. DTSC held a 45-day public comment period from November 17, 2006 to January 8, 2007 for the Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Draft Permit). DTSC did not hold a public meeting or a public hearing to receive comments on the Draft Permit since neither was requested and the only comments received by DTSC came from Safety-Kleen in writing dated December 22, 2006.

DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments document (RTC) and made changes to the Draft Permit. The RTC and a copy of the Final Permit are available for formal public review at the repositories listed at the end of the Notice.

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The Final Permit becomes effective on May 23, 2007 unless a review is requested through the permit appeal process pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the Draft Permit may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the Final Permit. Any person who did not provide comments on the Draft Permit may petition for review only to the extent of the changes from the Draft Permit to the Final Permit. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the petition, including a demonstration, if necessary, that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which the DTSC should, in its discretion, review.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC has determined that the environmental documents prepared for this Facility adequately addressed potential impacts associated with the issuance of the Final Permit. DTSC will file a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State of California, Office of Planning and Research, State Clearinghouse, upon the effective date of the Final Permit unless an appeal is filed with DTSC prior to the effective date.
