### **NOTICE OF FINAL PERMIT DECISION**

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) hereby provides this Notice of Final Permit Decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) to the following hazardous waste management facility:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company  
6875 Consolidated Way, SD1373  
San Diego, California 92121-2602  
US EPA ID Number: CAD 980636682

The final Permit authorizes San Diego Gas & Electric Company to continue operation as a hazardous waste storage facility. DTSC held a 45-day public comment period for the draft Permit and draft California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Notice of Exemption (NOE) from March 20, 2012 to May 3, 2012. As a result, one comment was received from the public which did not require any changes to the draft Permit. Please note that DTSC has also made minor editorial changes to the draft Permit during the public comment period. Those changes are explained in Response to Comments document. DTSC also filed a NOE for this permit renewal to comply with CEQA.

This permit action constitutes a final permit decision under title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), section 66271.14. The final permit decision shall become effective on July 3, 2012 and expires on July 2, 2022, unless the permit decision is appealed pursuant to 22, CCR, Section 66271.18.

Pursuant to 22, CCR, section 66271.18, any person who filed comments on the draft permit may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Persons who did not file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only on the changes that were made from the draft to the final permit decision. Petitions must include a statement of the reasons supporting the requested review, including a demonstration that any issues raised during the public comment period, or address a change from the draft to final permit decision. Petitions should also, as appropriate, show that the condition in question is based on:

- (1) A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous; or
- (2) An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review. Petitions must be postmarked by no later than July 2, 2012, and
