## DTSC Approves Permit Renewal for the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station

The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) provides this Notice of Decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) to the following hazardous waste management facility:

San Onofre Nuclear Generating Facility  
5000 PacificCoastHighway  
San Clemente, California 92672  
EPA ID No. CAD000630921

This Permit renewal action constitutes a final decision under the California Code of Regulations, section 66271.14. The final Permit renewal decision shall become effective on May 23, 2016 unless the Permit renewal decision is appealed pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18.

The Permit is for the application submitted by the facility to DTSC dated October 13, 2015. A public comment period was held from January 7, 2016 through February 24, 2016 and a public hearing was held on February 11, 2016.

Under the California Code of Regulations, section 66271.18, any person who filed comments on a draft permit may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit renewal decision. Persons who did not file comments on a draft permit may petition for administrative review only on the changes that were made from the draft to the final permit decision. Petitions must include a statement of the reasons supporting the requested review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, or address a change from the draft to final Permit renewal decision. Petitions should also, as appropriate, show that the condition in question is based on: (1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous; or (2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.

Petitions must be postmarked by no later than May 23, 2016. You may mail your petition to the Permit Appeals Officer at the following address:
