NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Southern California Gas Co. – Olympic Base
2424 East Olympic Blvd.
Los Angeles, California 90021
Los Angeles County

On December 4, 2006, DTSC informed the public of a 60-day public comment period on the draft permit and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) draft Notice of Exemption (NOE). That comment period ran from December 4, 2006 through February 1, 2007.

Comments were received by electronic and postal mail. DTSC has prepared a Response to the Comments document and made changes to the Draft Permit. A copy of the Response to Comments documents has been sent to each commenter. The Response to Comments document, the DTSC memorandum to file listing the revisions made to the Draft Permit in response to public comments, and a redline/strikeout version of the permit showing all the changes from the Draft to the Final permit, are available to the public at the repositories listed at the end of this Notice. In its role as Lead Agency under the provisions of the CEQA, DTSC prepared an NOE to evaluate potential impacts from the proposed permit renewal.

Within 30 days after a final permit decision has been issued under CCR, title 22, section 66271.14, any person who filed comments on that draft permit may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. The 30-day period within which a person may request review under section 66271.18 begins on April 3, 2007 and ends on May 3, 2007. The permit becomes effective on May 4, 2007, unless a petition for review is filed. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, or were not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the public comment period. When appropriate, the petition must show that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law that is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.
