NOTIFICATION OF FINAL DECISION, HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY POST CLOSURE PERMIT FOR TFX AVIATION, INCORPORATED, NEWBURY PARK, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER CAD008383127

Dear Ms. Salinas:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to approve the Hazardous Waste Facility Post Closure Permit for the TFX Aviation Incorporated, Newbury Park Facility.

A public comment period was held from April 16, and ended on June 3, 2016. DTSC announced the public comment period in a community notice mailed on April 14, 2016, and a public notice was published in a newspaper publication, radio advertisement and DTSC website postings on or about April 16, 2016. A public hearing was held on May 18, 2016 at 6:00 pm. Only 2 people attended the public hearing. DTSC received 1 public comment submittal during the public comment period.

The final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with California Code of Regulation, title 22, section 66271.14. Unless review is requested pursuant to the procedures found in section 66271.18, the final permit decision will become effective on July 23, 2016.

Procedures for appealing a permit decision are described in California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Within 30 days after a final permit decision has been issued under section 66271.14, any person who filed comments on that draft permit or participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. The 30-day period

within which a person may request review under this section begins with this service of notice of DTSC's action and ends on July 23, 2016. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including the public hearing) to the extent required by these regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which the Department should, in its discretion, review.

A petition must be postmarked no later than July 23, 2016, and must be submitted to:
