NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE POST-CLOSURE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION TESORO REFINING AND MARKETING COMPANY, LOS ANGELES REFINERY

To Interested Parties:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Post Closure Permit for Ponds 8 and 9 at the Tesoro Los Angeles Refinery at 2101 East Pacific Coast Highway, Wilmington, California 90744. The Final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14.

The final Permit becomes effective on March 17, 2011 unless a review is requested pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Within 30 days after a final permit decision is issued, any person who filed comments on that draft permit or participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft permit to the final permit. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including any public hearing) and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on: (1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous; or 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review. The Permit shall take effect on the effective date if DTSC does not receive any petition within the 30-day period which ends on March 17, 2011.
