PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: April 7, 2011 - May 6, 2011

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to comment on the draft Corrective Measure Proposal (CMP) for the Tyco Electronics Corporation, located at 1950 West Fremont Street, Stockton. During environmental site investigations, elevated levels of lead were detected in the soil. The lead impacted soil is located below the concrete floor of the building, and also below an existing concrete pad just outside the building. The draft CMP proposes to place a deed restriction on the property that would limit property use to industrial/commercial.

This notice provides the community an opportunity to learn more about the project and provide comments to DTSC about the proposed CMP during the public comment period, which runs from **April 7, 2011 through May 6, 2011**.
