PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: July 9, 2007 to August 22, 2007

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a draft permit renewal for United Technologies Corporation, a hazardous waste storage facility, located at 600 Metcalf Road in San Jose.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the renewed permit would allow the facility to continue to store hazardous waste while the facility is undergoing closure. An example of the types of wastes that United Technologies Corporation stores are: petroleum hydrocarbons, waste oil, adhesives, solvents, building debris, etc. A complete list of waste that the facility stores is available in the permit renewal documents located in the repository listed below.

As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft permit renewal as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption in connection with this project.
