The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is accepting public comment on the Draft Post-Closure Permit for three former surface impoundments at the United Technologies Corporation Facility (Facility). DTSC is also accepting public comment on the Proposed California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Draft Negative Declaration. The former manufacturing Facility is located at 600 Metcalf Road in San Jose, California in Santa Clara County.

**The public comment period begins on September 28, 2006 and ends on November 13, 2006.**

Before making a final determination on the Post-Closure Permit and Draft Negative Declaration, DTSC will review and respond to all public comments in writing. The DTSC Response to Comments will be sent to all individuals who submitted comments, made comments at the public hearing, or those who requested a copy. A copy will also be placed in the information repositories listed in the Fact Sheet.

The Post-Closure Permit applies to three former surface impoundments. The Permit requires continued groundwater monitoring, pumping and treatment.
