NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION VEOLIA ES TECHNICAL SOLUTIONS, L.L.C., RICHMOND FACILITY (EPA ID: CAT080014079)

To Interested Party:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) for the Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C., located at 1125 Hensley St. Richmond, California 94801. The final Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14.

DTSC has also issued a Negative Declaration Document for this Permit to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Because some members of the community may not have received notification of the previous public comment period held from February 11th through March 28th, 2014, another 45-day public comment period was held from June 27th to August 11th, 2014.

DTSC received comments via e-mail on August 8th from Mr. John Schofield and Mr. Richard Francis of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments document and made changes to the Draft Permit.

The final permit decision shall become effective on October 8th, 2014 and shall expire on October 8th, 2024, unless a review is requested pursuant to the California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft permit may petition the Department to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. The petition to review shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period to the extent required by these regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or

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2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which the Department should, in its discretion, review.
