Dear DTSE,

I have been a homeowner for the last 9 years in a residential track just north of this proposed site. It seems to me that there are already more than enough hazards companies in this area. The air quality needs to be tested more stringently for lead and cadmium. There are metal recycling plants, recycling centers and such in these areas that pollute the air. The cities of Fontana, Ontario and Rancho Cucamonga have allowed too many of these companies in our backyard so to speak.

My neighbor behind me lost his wife to cancer, my neighbor west of me lost her husband to cancer, a friends husband is battling cancer now one street south of me, I have had a tumor removed from the back of my skull. I have heard from other neighbor that there have been many others that have died from cancer over the years. Is this just coincidence or is their trace amount of poison in the air we breath? I don't know.

Before you grant Advanced Environmental Inc. a permit to handle even more toxic substances I think you should come out hear and look around the areas. I think further testing needs to be done. My neighborhood was built in the mid fifties and was hear before these businesses were built, it is not fair they keep bringing in more toxics.

Just to let you know the city of Rancho Cucamonga with be breaking ground on a 225 unit low income apartment complex about a ¼ mile north of the site. It will be located on Foothill Boulevard at the southeast corner of East Ave. and Foothill Blvd. They will be breaking ground the first part of 2009. I know low income subsidized complexes must fallow strick guidelines for the health of the occupants.

I am not saying they should not build the complex, but I don't think air quality test were very through as they did not do a full E.I.R. on the project, they only did a mitigated decoration..
