**Draft Interim Remedial Measures Work Plan
For
Cherry Aerospace
Public Comment Period: May 8 – June 8, 2015**

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED: The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites your comments on the draft Interim Remedial Measures Work Plan (IRMWP) for Chery Aerospace, located at 1224 East Warner Avenue, Santa Ana, California (Site). The purpose of the IRMWP is to reduce concentrations of onsite chemicals in soil and groundwater, and further reduce the potential for offsite migration of chemicals.

Based on the current information, the chemicals in the soil and groundwater do not pose immediate health concern, and local drinking water meets all applicable State and Federal standards. However, interim measures are necessary to protect public health and the environment.

The IRMWP proposes to (1) to control the offsite migration of the impacted groundwater present at the Site and (2) to reduce chemicals at source areas to minimize the migration of contaminants from the soil into groundwater. A total of 32 wells and an onsite treatment system will be installed within the facility.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): In compliance with CEQA, DTSC has determined that the impact to human health and the environment would be less than significant and a Negative Declaration has been prepared for this project.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: We encourage your participation. Comments concerning the draft IRMWP and the associated CEQA Negative Declaration may be submitted in writing to Chia Rin Yen, DTSC Project Manager, 5796 Corporate Avenue, Cypress, CA, 90630 or ChiaRin.Yen@dtsc.ca.gov. All emailed or written comments must be received or postmarked no later than **June 8, 2015**. All comments will be considered by DTSC before making a final decision. DTSC's Response to Comments will be provided to all who submit their contact information along with their comments, and those who request a copy. A public meeting has not been scheduled for this project.
