Dear Ms. Batarseh:

This acknowledges receipt of the January 30, 2015 Department of Toxic Substance Control ("DTSC") letter addressed to Chromalox and entitled "Settlement of the Summary of Violations" ("Settlement of SOV"). This will advise you that Chromalox concurs with the approach suggested in your letter for negotiating a resolution of this matter. Chromalox would obviously need to know what the proposed settlement terms are before it could commit to them, but it is confident that a smaller group will develop a proposal that is mutually acceptable. Chromalox is *de minimis* participant in the California market, so it would not make sense to participate as one of the negotiating entities. However, it has recently learned that TRC members are attempting to organize a group to discuss the issues with DTSC. Please advise if you require any additional information from Chromalox at this time.
