Re: January 30, 2014 Letter from DTSC re Settlement of Summary of Violations (SOV)

Dear Ms. Batarseh and Mr. Diebert:

Goodman Global, Inc. ("Goodman") received your agency's letter dated January 30, 2014, which proposes continued dialogue and efforts to work through TRC and its members to reach an amicable resolution with DTSC of the asserted violations. Goodman remains willing to discuss the alleged violations in the SOV with DTSC, but also wishes to continue to participate in a common collection program and to work with the other members of TRC to seek an agreed resolution on behalf of all relevant manufacturers. Goodman is, therefore, generally amenable to the approach outlined in your January 30 letter. Please note, however, that Goodman cannot commit in advance to any of the specific program enhancements described in the attachment to your letter. Nevertheless, we look forward to participating in good faith negotiations with DTSC to resolve the SOV.
