Dear Ms. Batarseh:

This will acknowledge receipt (on February 4, 2015) of your letter dated January 30, 2015 concerning the July 3, 2104 Summary of Violation letter. We appreciate your willingness to continue a constructive dialogue aimed at resolving the issues set forth in your July 3, 2014 letter.

Lear Siegler agrees that it would be more efficient and effective for all concerned if a subset of manufacturers were to negotiate with DTSC to arrive at changes to the collection program. Assuming that most of the manufacturers are in agreement, it will take time for the manufacturers to form a collective interest group and for that group to be in a position to respond on a substantive basis. Accordingly, we would ask for a 30 day extension of the date by which Lear Siegler must further respond to your letter of January 30, 2015.
