OPPORTUNITIES FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing a public notice for a proposed Closure Plan and proposed Notice of Exemption for the Southern California Edison, Mandalay Generating Station (SCE), located at 8996 Etiwanda Avenue, in city of Rancho Cucamonga (San Bernardino County). SCE is closing its three retention basins according to the closure requirements specified in Title 22, California Code of Regulations, Chapter 15, Article 7. A notice announcing the public comment period for the proposed Draft Closure Demonstration Report and a proposed Notice of Exemption in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) will be published in the Inland Valley Daily Bulletin on May 16, 2011. A mailing list consisting of elected officials, government agencies, homeowners associations, community persons, and other interested parties has been established. Public notice will be sent to all individuals on the mailing list.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

A 30-day public comment period will be held to provide interested individuals with an opportunity to comment on the proposed Closure Plan and proposed Notice of Exemption for SCE. The comment period will begin May 16, 2011 and end June 17, 2011.
