THE PROPOSED REMEDY THE FORMER SPECIAL DEVICES INCORPORATED SITE NEWHALL, LOS ANGELES COUNTY March 19 to May 4, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the Draft Corrective Measures Study (CMS) and Proposed Remedy for the former Special Devices Incorporated Site in Newhall. This Proposed Remedy presents the results of the chemical contamination investigation done for the seven different areas or levels of this former facility. These areas are located within the Angeles National Forest at 16830 West Placerita Canyon Road, about one mile west of Sand Canyon Road in Newhall in Los Angeles County.
