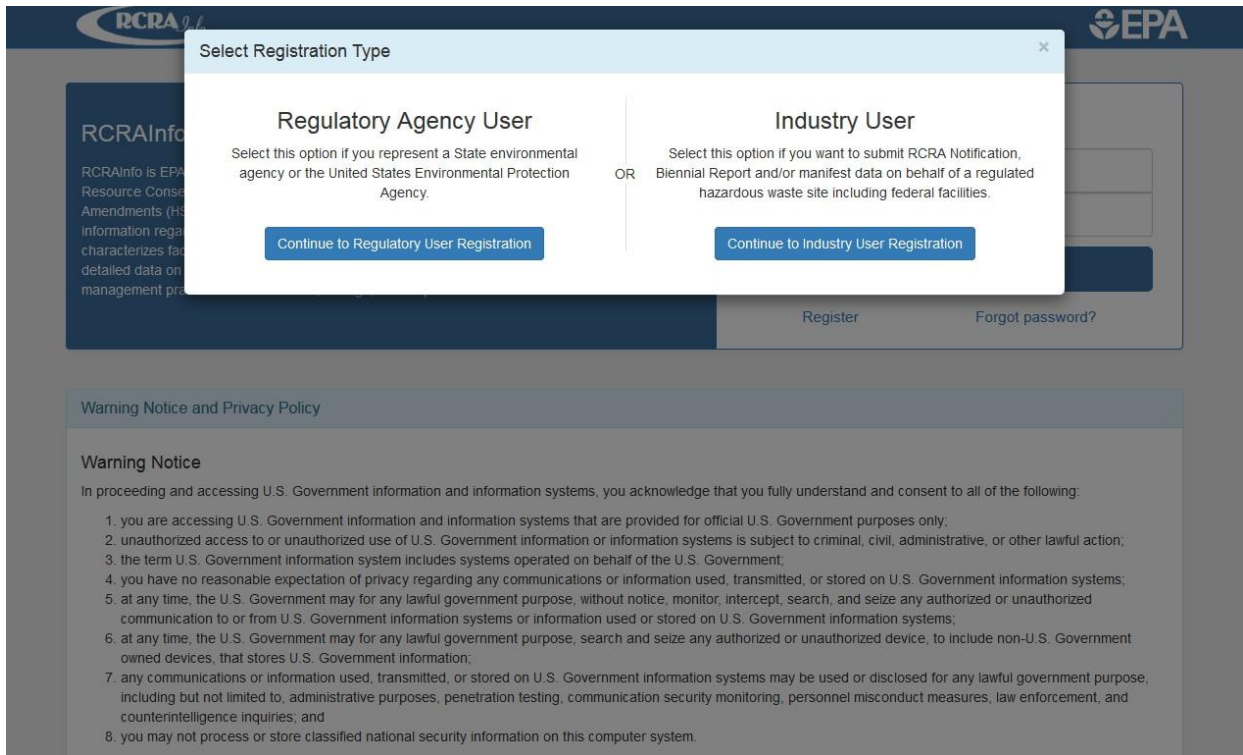
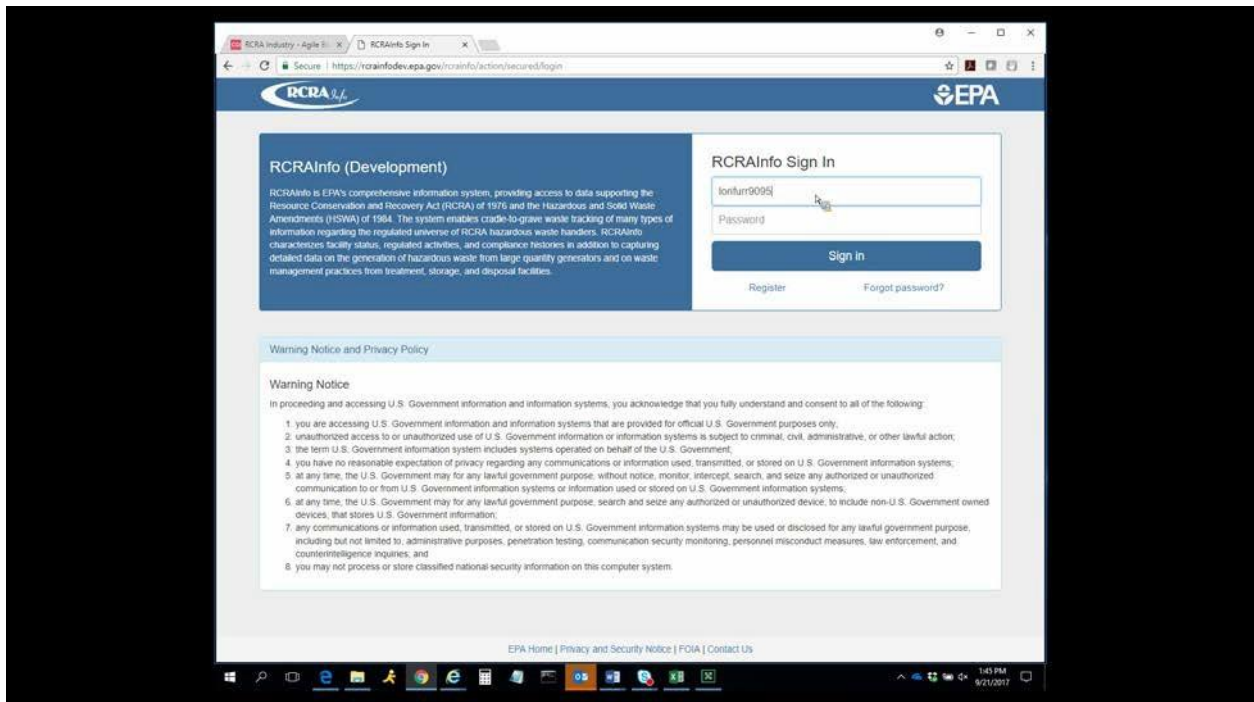


# REGISTERING AS AN INDUSTRY USER IN RCRAINFO




If you already registered through CDX, sign in, using your user name and password you used when using CDX.

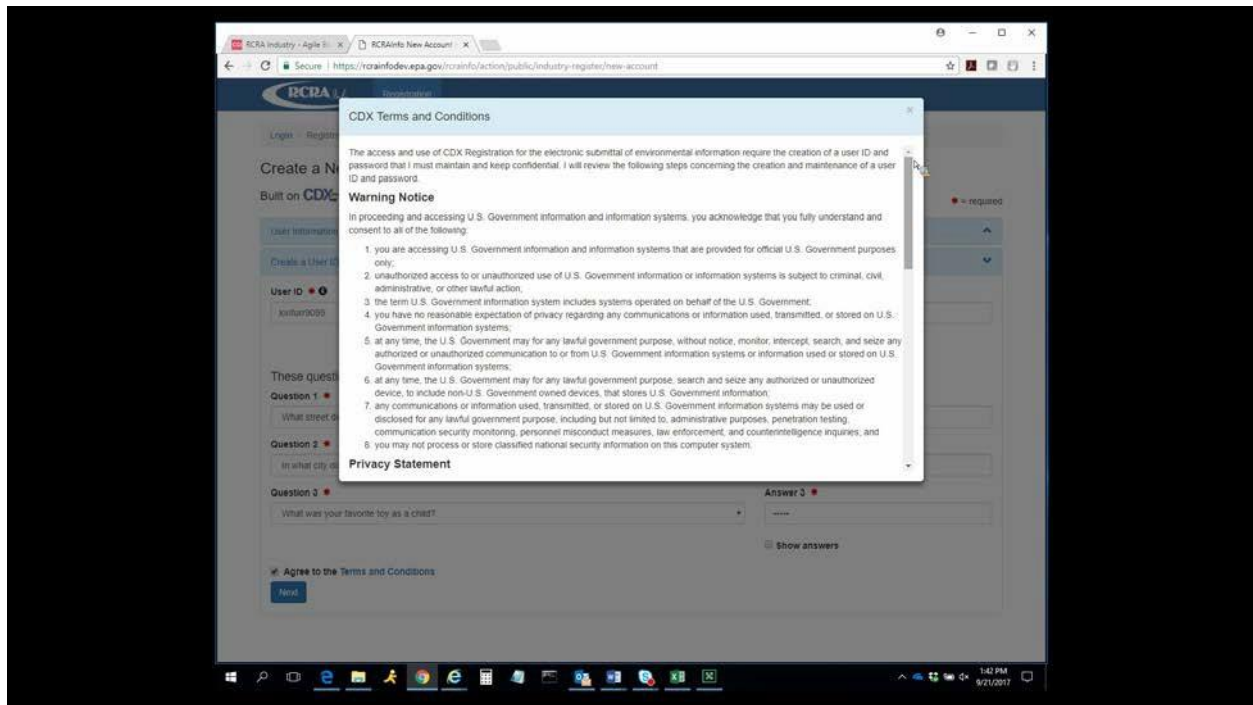

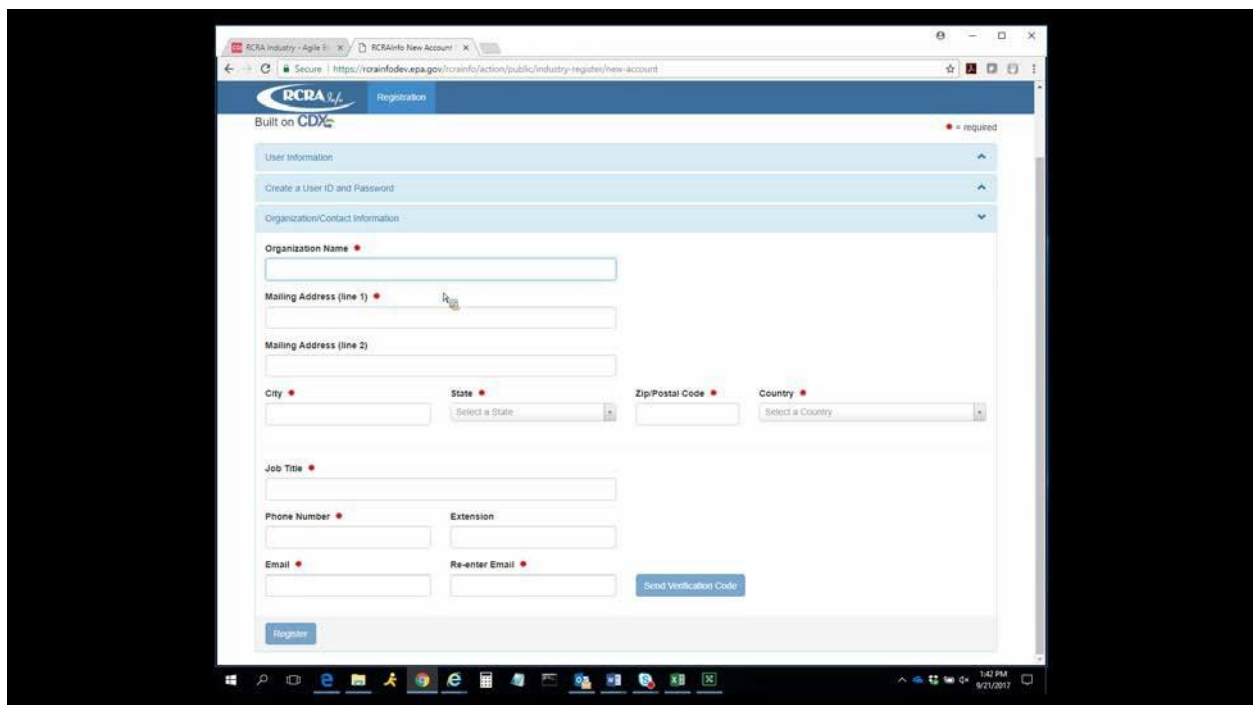




You must agree to the Terms and Conditions to continue to the next screen.



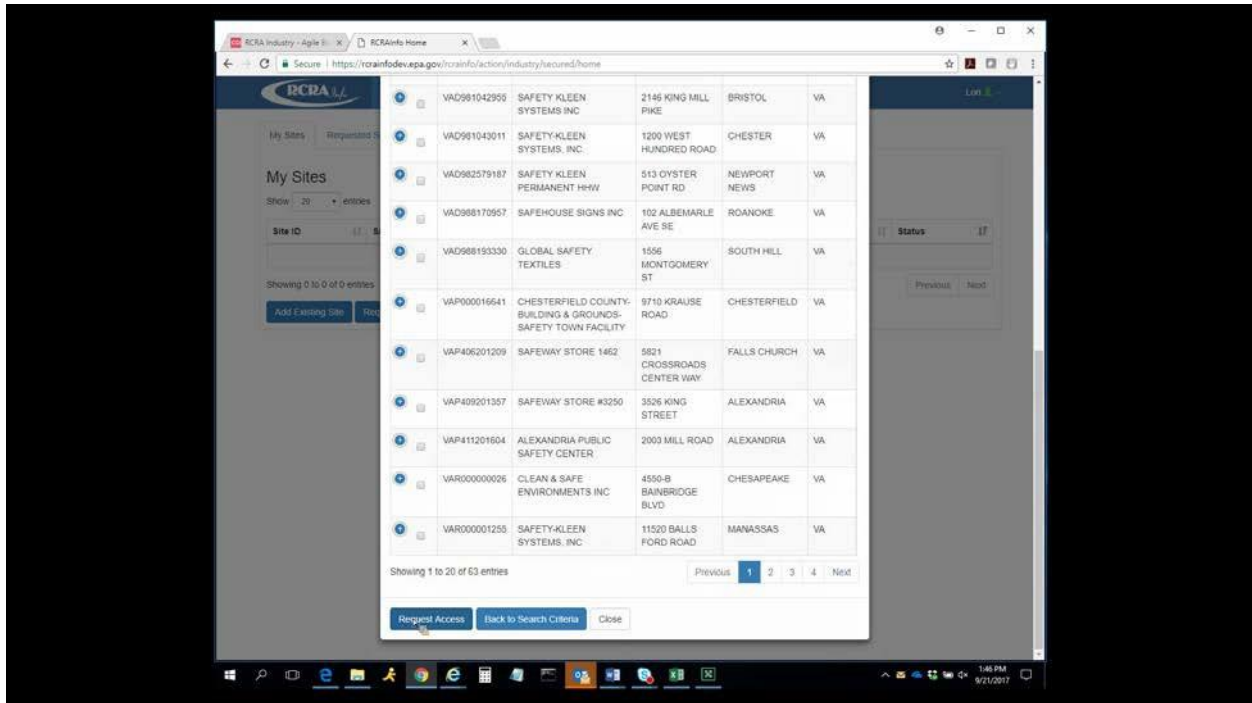


Select "California" from the drop-down box.

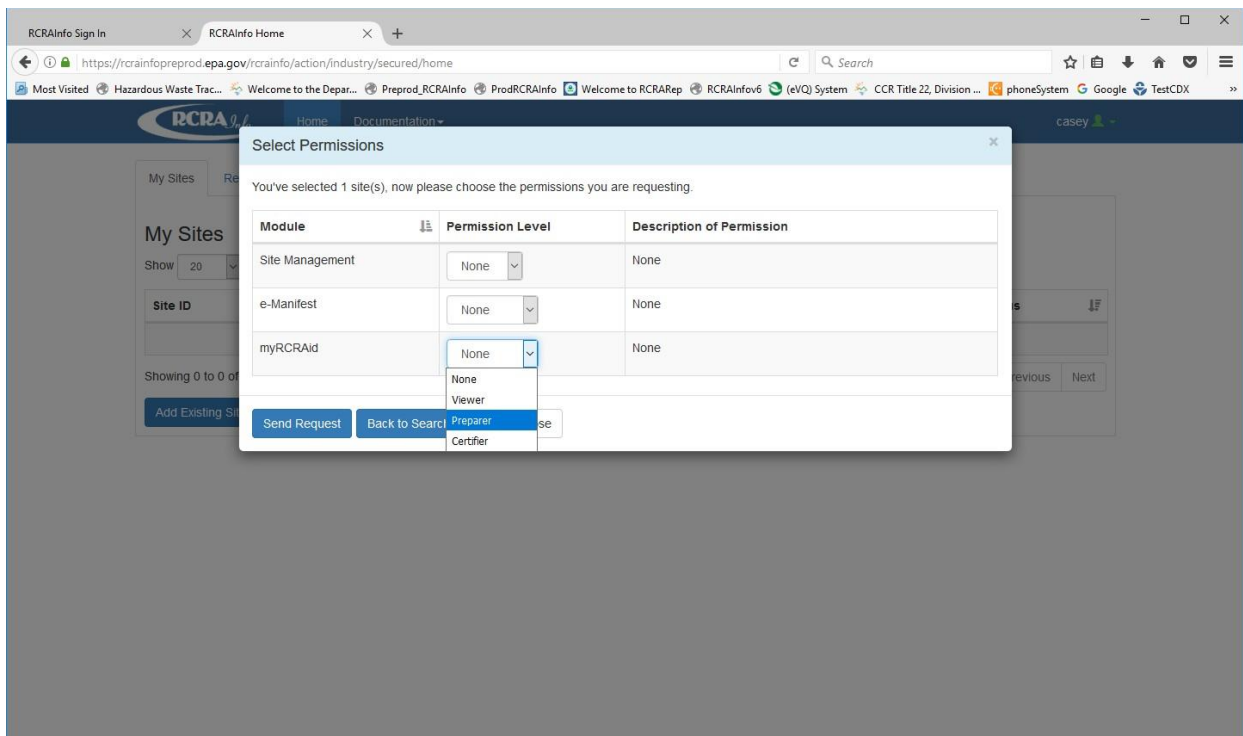

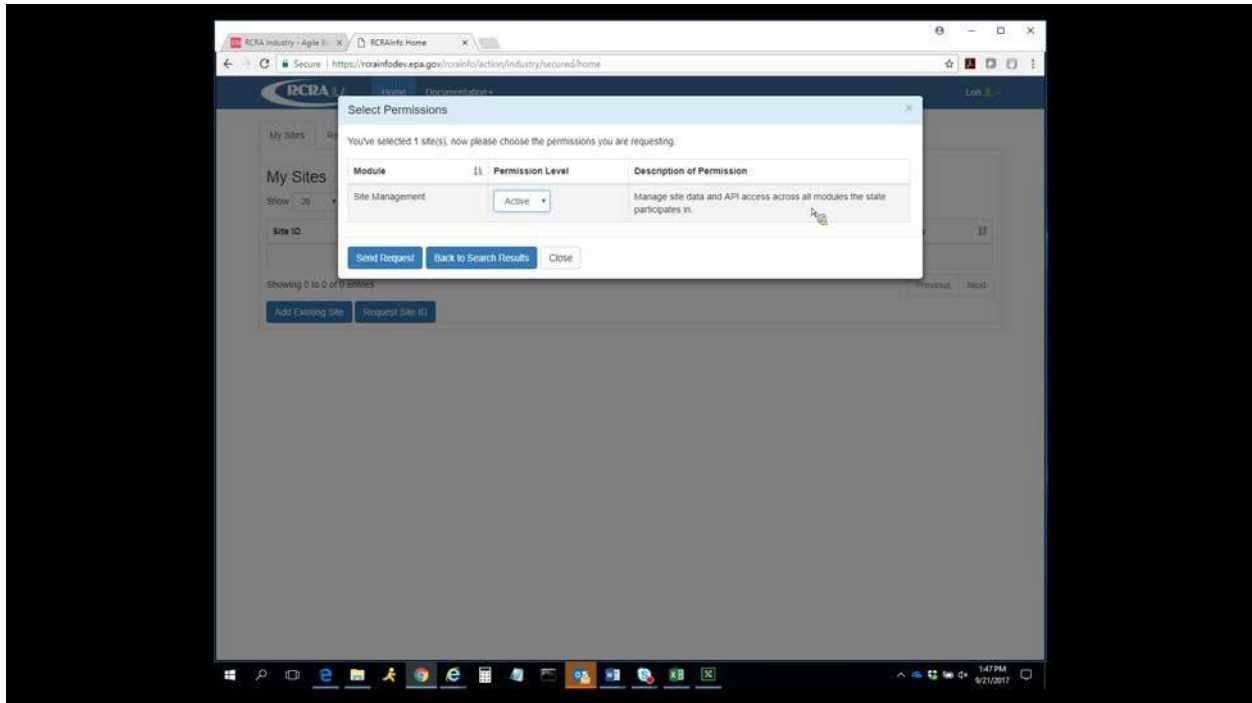
