Pursuant to Cal. Code Regs title 2, section 18750, subdivision (d), notice is hereby given that the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has revised the text of the proposed regulations, which would now specify minimum levels of five designated employee classifications. A written comment period has been established commencing on August 2, 2005, and closing on August 16, 2005.

DTSC mailed the original text and made it available for public review and comment on May 31, 2005. A public hearing was held on July 25, 2005 during which written and oral testimony was accepted. In addition, written comments were accepted during the 45-day public comment period that ended July 25, 2005. DTSC has now made post-hearing changes to the proposed text.

This notice includes all revisions made to the text since those indicated during the original public comment period.
