Notice of Availability to Review Proposed Plans for Addressing Contamination at Installation Restoration Sites 1111 and 22/23 Area Groundwater at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton

Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton invites the public to comment on the Proposed Plans for Installation Restoration (IR) Site 1111 and the 22/23 Area Groundwater site. The Proposed Plan for Site 1111 documents that cleanup has occurred at the site and no further action needs to be taken. The Proposed Plan for the 22/23 Area Groundwater site identifies the preferred alternatives for addressing contaminated groundwater at this site and provides the reasoning for these preferences. The Proposed Plans are part of the IR Program, a Department of Defense program for investigating, characterizing, and cleaning up soil and groundwater contamination resulting from past years of operation at military bases.

The preferred cleanup alternatives for these sites are considered the best approaches to protect the public and the environment and comply with regulatory requirements. The regulatory agencies reviewing the IR Program concur with these preferred alternatives. The agencies that oversee the IR Program are the USEPA, California Regional Water Quality Control Board, and the California Department of Toxic Substances Control.
